HAPPY, HEALTHY NEW YEAR to you all from your Historical Society officers.







God is like Alka-Seltzer - Try Him, you'll like Him.






I've just received word that Irene, Willie, Clare and Rudy have been under the weather during the holidays. Hope by this time, everyone is doing well. Also get well Lorraine.
