Message From The President

Parade volunteers at each location will have any last minute instructions.

Parade volunteers designated to guide entries along the parade route will wear brightly-colored, orange vests to clearly distinguish them from volunteers assigned to crowd control.

The Wheeling Police Department will assist in directing traffic throughout the parade route. They will also serve as designated first responders in the event of an emergency situation. In the event of an emergency, call 9-1-1.

The Wheeling Fire Department will also be designated first responders in the event of a 9-1-1 call.



- 1. Parade entry drivers must be prepared to stop at any time to allow other entries to enter the parade. Parade entry drivers must obey the instructions of parade volunteers and emergency personnel at all times.
- 1. Walking entry participants should not be loaded or unloaded in the street under any circumstances as this poses a serious safety issue.
- 1. Parade volunteers will assist marching bands in lining up in the appropriate order. At the end of the parade route, parade volunteers will direct bands back to their buses to travel to Wheeling High School.
- 1. Parade participants will not be allowed to ride on the hood or roof of parade vehicles.
- 1. Parade officials reserve the right to remove entries from the parade lineup for unsafe or inappropriate behavior, or for use of inappropriate or potentially disruptive signage and/or language.
- 1. Throwing of candy, food items, toys or any other object from floats, decorated vehicles, walking entries, or any parade participant is strictly prohibited.
- 1. Entries wishing to distribute such it must designate walkers to accompany their entry and hand the items to spectators. Violators will be asked to leave the parade
- 2. In the event of rain and/or lightning at 10:30 a.m., the parade start will be postponed until 12:00 Noon. If threatening weather conditions are still present at 1:00 p.m., the parade will be cancelled. Parade volunteers at each starting position will promptly inform parade participants of changes affecting the start time of the parade.


We are getting ready to open the museum on April 12th. Anyone wanting to volunteer to sit on a Sunday afternoon can contact me at (847)924-4473.
