

Third graders at Hawthorn Intermediate School in Vernon Hills and Woodview School in Grayslake recently shared their recipes for their Thanksgiving repasts with a hungry reporter.

For readers who could use a fresh look at traditional holiday dishes, the youngsters' ideas may provide inspiration.

PUMPKIN PIE

Caitlin Poore's family clearly has a big appetite. Her recipe calls for 61h cups of pumpkin squash, one cup of water, $3\frac{1}{2}$ cups of sugar, 6 1/4 cups of vinegar, four pounds of dough and 3¹/₂ cups of flour. "First," she explains, "put the cup of water in an 1/8-inch bowl." Then the Hawthorn student suggests adding the pumpkin squash, flour, vinegar and the dough, mixing thoroughly. "If you're using your hand, stir 176 times," she specifies. "If you're using a mixer, use it for two minutes." Then, she concludes, bake it in the oven for two hours. Woodview student Angela Stoczanskyz advises a supply of sugar, filling, vanilla and brown sugar. "Then bake the crust," she instructs and, "while the pie crust is baking, you put the sugar in, then the vanilla, then the brown sugar, then the cinnamon." She seems to have forgotten the most vital ingredient, but nobody's perfect.


