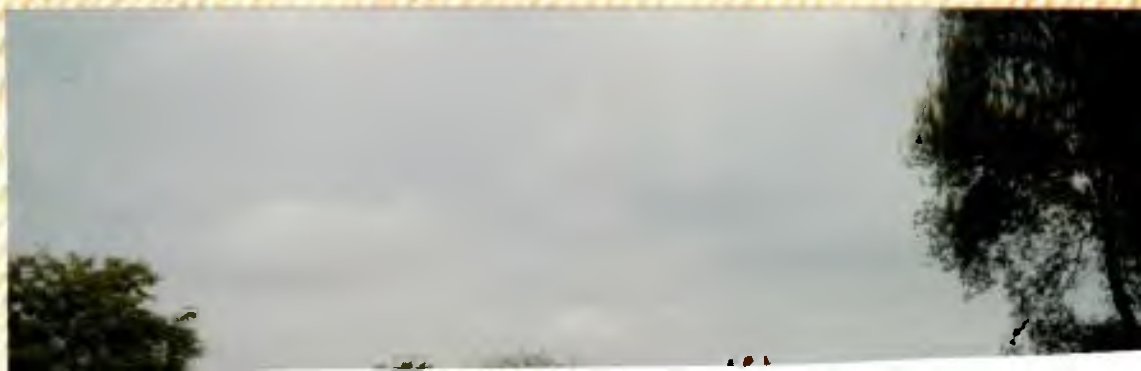

Although actually thinner in size than cast iron pipe, Ductile Iron is significantly stronger and flexible in nature. This new pipe will be wrapped in plastic to increase its resistance to corrosion.
