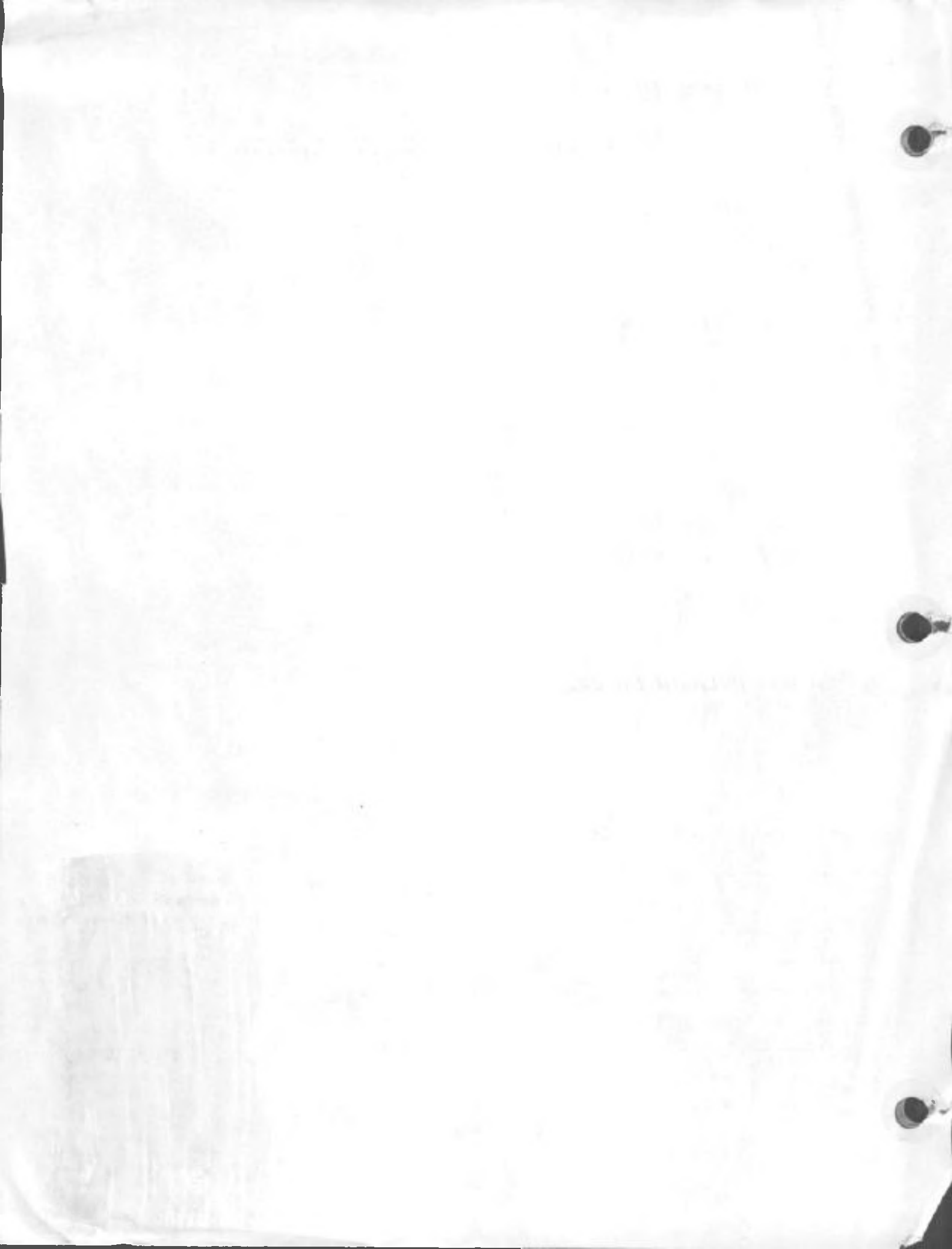

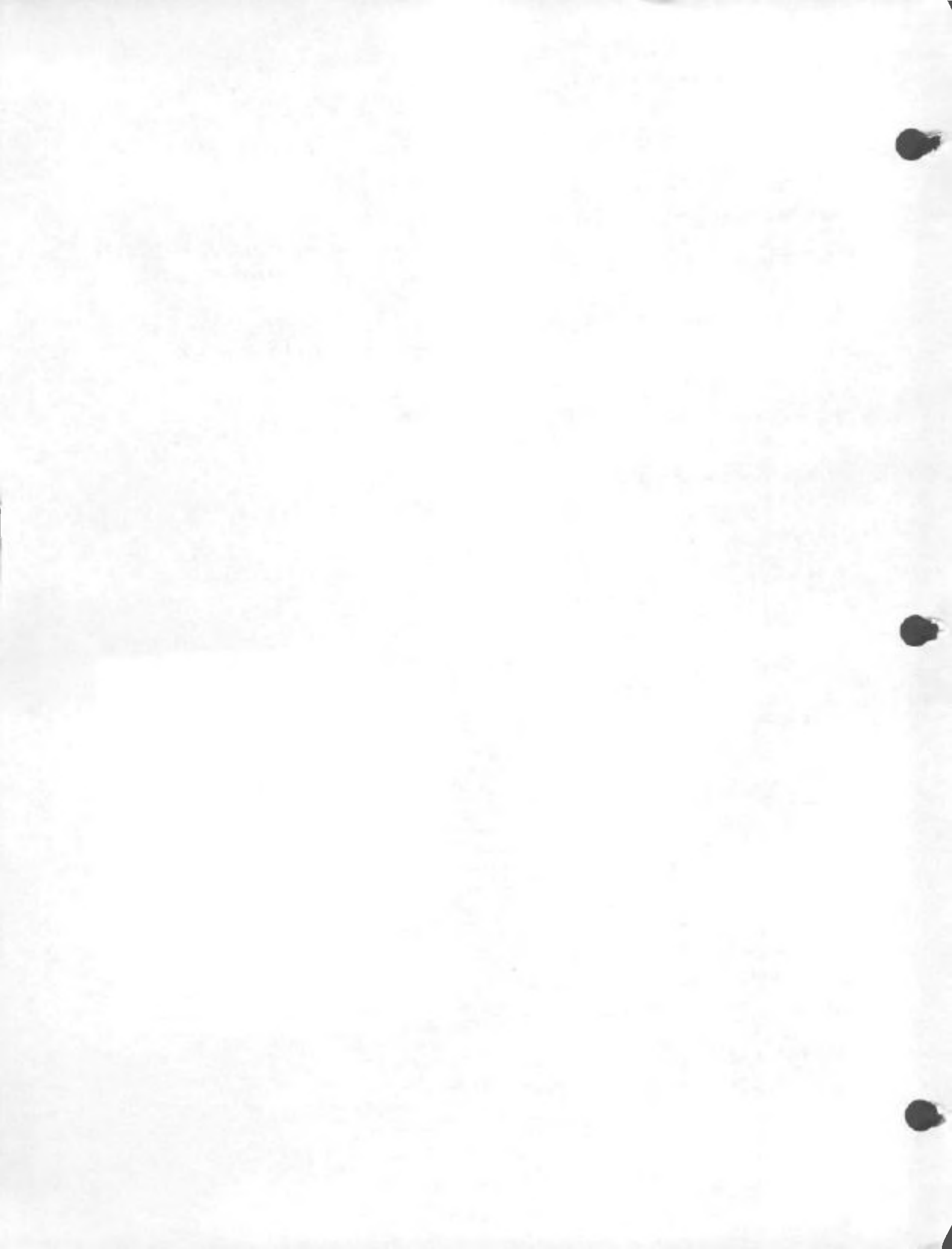
Born Dec. 4, 1897, in Des Plaines, Mr. Jaacks was a retired farmer.

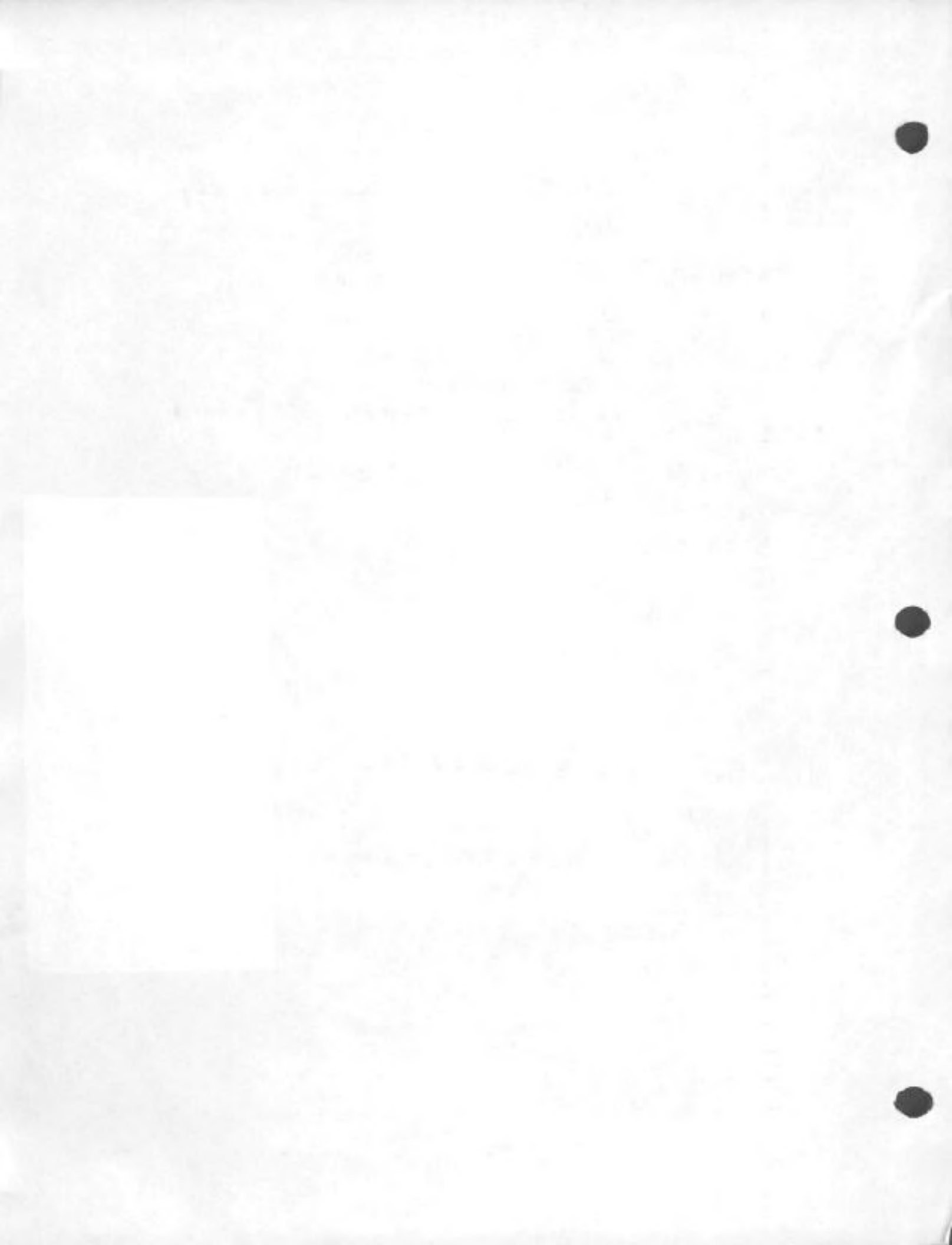
MR. CHAS. JOHNSON
