WHEELING - Jan P. Vanderspool was born October 15, 1933 in Chicago to Peter H. and Winifred (Piper) Vanderspool. He died Friday, December 8, 2017 at Lutheran Home in Arlington Heights, Illinois. Mr. Vanderspool began working in the construction trades as a bricklayer. After frequent masonry jobs at Lutheran General Hospital, he was offered a permanent job as Assistant to Superintendent of Buildings and Grounds in 1971. He continued to serve as Construction and Remodeling Manager, Project Engineer, and Project Leader until after normal retirement age. When the hospital became part of the Advocate Health Care system, he continued as the hospital's locksmith until he retired after 32 years. Jan's knack for seeking out and solving problems was clear in high school when he claimed an abandoned popcorn wagon. His father helped him lease land where he could rebuild the wagon. Another leased location at the end of the Milwaukee Avenue streetcar line became a thriving part-time business. In his free

time, Jan enjoyed repurposing scrapped materials into something useful. In one project, he took junked hospital glass panels and built a tool shop, complete with a retractable roof for added ventilation. He found nothing more satisfying than the hunt to assemble unrelated pieces into a masterpiece. Jan is survived by his son Jan P. (Nanette) Vanderspool II; his sister Madlynne K. Vanderspool; his nieces, Glory Reynolds of Clinton, Iowa and Richey Vanderspool of White Heath, Illinois; his nephew Robert Vanderspool of Fond du Lac, Wisconsin; and his long-time friend, Cecilia Barin. Vernon E. Verstraete ~ 1923-2006

His vision helped shape Chevy Chase golf course

Wheeling Park District officials said they credit Vernon E. Verstraete, their longtime golf pro at Chevy Chase Country Club, with wearing many hats, from teaching professional, to groundskeeper to banker.

"He was passionate about the game — and this place," said Jan Buchs, park district executive.

Mr. Verstraete, a Wheeling resident, died Saturday. He was 82.

Buchs recounted the story he said everyone remembers, from when the park district took over the historic course in 1977. The district hired Mr. Verstraete to run the club because of his role as park superintendent with the downstate Kewaunee, Ill. park district.

"There's this story that when the park district took over the course, he started the cash box with his own \$20," Buchs said.

At the 2002 grand opening of the Traditions at Chevy Chase, park board President Tom Weber gave Mr. Verstraete his \$20 back, which they had framed.

"When the park district took over the golf course, it was pretty lean," Weber said. "He had all the responsibility of the golf operation and had to do everything without much money."

Bob Falkiner, golf operations manager and head professional,

remembered Mr. Verstraete promoting the course in the community and working to bring rounds in.

"He essentially resurrected it," Falkiner says.

Mr. Verstraete taught golf lessons as well, taking a special interest in beginners. He worked to develop the park district's junior league golf program, and volunteered to work with junior golfers after his retirement in 2002.

Park district officials undertook a massive renovation of the 125-acre course — which dates to 1926 — and tapped Mr. Ver-

straete for his input.

"This course now is a real shining star in Wheeling, with its history and all," Falkiner adds. "But (Mr. Verstraete) laid the foundation for that. Without his vision, it never would have been here."

Mr. Verstraete is survived by his wife of 61 years, Vivian, four children, five grandchildren and four great grandchildren.
