kide that went to esheel went to a two floor, two room school-house named Walt Whitman. The kids were put into any classroom, The classes were full of different ages. Children had to wait for the teacher to teach them.

Bob Chin's Crab House was a turn of the century whore house and a spaghetti house. Behind the Crab House there was an ice house. Billy and Company was the Village Hall Harry Carey's was a speakeasy. Harry Carey's and Chevy Chase had an underground tunnel that gangsters used a lot. The tunnel started to collapse so, they got rid of it.

Welcome dear friends to the town of Wheeling. My name is Caitlin Boehmer, daughter of Henry Boehmer, our Village President. It is the year 1894 and we are now celebrating the Sixtieth Anniversary of the Village of Wheeling. Will you accompany me on a trip to the past?

It was Joseph Filkins who built the first residence here in 1834. As the population grew in the village, a post office was established in 1836. In a few years, many businesses opened. They appeared as early as the 1850's. There were hotels, blacksmith's, wagonshop's, stores, and creameries. In fact, my father opened a creamery in 1880. He sold it a while later,

As for our life here, it's a nice and peaceful town. We have reunions on days such as the 4th of July and other important dates for the village. One of the great sites here is the Des Plaines River. On Sunday's, the Wheeling Cornet Band plays there and families gather around to sing and dance along. We also have bicycle races from Wheeling to Chicago. Even one of my brother's participated in one. He came in fourth, and not bad for a skinny little boy out of 100!

The Wheeling Township was organized on April second, 1850. Some of the supervisors were Joseph Filkins, William Scoville, George Strong, William H. Dutton, Frederich Tesh, and David Peters. The first church was built in 1865 and was called "The German Evangelical United Reformed and Lutheran Church." The first pastor was Reverend F.C.Schwartz. From what I've hears, my old elementary school's name is going to be changed to Walt Whitman. I'm not sure, but I'll find out! Our doctor's name is M. Moffat and he has worked here since 1876, but he retired in 1890. He was really kind to all of us! I can still remember when he always gave us lollipops because of a few scrapes on our knees. Our railroad was built in 1886, and it is located one mile from here. We don't have a Fire Department yet, but I hear we are considering it, for the safty of our townspeople!

On June 18, 1894 an election was held in Union Hall to decide whether there should be a Village organization. The results were 43 yes and 3 no. For almost a month, men ran for different kinds of offices. July 17, 1894 the results for the village president, trustees, Village clerk, and Police magistrate were given. Henry Boehmer, my father, was named Village President. The six trustees were John Forke, Jacob Schwigel, Emil Sigwalt, Reinhold Schneider, William Fassbender, and J.A.Schminke. The Police Magistrate was Louis Fischer. Finally, the Village Clerk was W.R.Munkhenke. The state approved the Articles of Incorporation on August 6. So far, everything has been great for these men. We all depend on them to keep us safe and to make the right decisions.

Well, that's the past of Wheeling. Hopefully, it will live on in the hearts of the townspeople and it will be brought down through the ages of our children, for them to teach to their generation. I hope you enjoyed our trip through time and please take care of the village. For it is the only key we have to open the door to the past. Good-bye!

My Family Roots In Wheeling by Matt Koelper, Grade 8, Holmes

My family roots in Wheeling go back a long time. I have had five generations of members in Wheeling. The town has changed a lot from what it used to be. Many things they used to have are now gone. It was a totally different place. Back then they had a mill, a blacksmith, a general store which sold basic needs, and a hospital. My grandpa took corn and oats to the mill to be ground. The mill also made cider. There was also a pumping station which took water through wooden tunnels to the steam engines to help them run. Wheeling Farms was there too. They had chickens, eggs, and pigeons. All of this is where Cole Taylor bank is on Dundee Road.

My great-great-grandpa on my mother's side owned a farm on the corner of Hintz and Wheeling road. He moved to that house when he was twenty years old in 1904. The house was where Wheeling High High School is now. They lived in an old farm house. The nearest neighbor was 1/4 mile north and 3/4 miles west. My grandpa was the older one of two children. His sister died when she was only three. He has lived there since he was born. He farmed a lot. He pitched corn and grain. He moved away when he married in 1942. Wheeling fire station #2 now stands where that farm used to be. When my grandpa got older he became an electrician. He did work all over the Wheeling area for many years.

My grandma and her family lived on Portwine road. Whe went to Wheeling school which is now Walt Whitman school when she was a little girl. There were only two rooms in that building! Grades 1-4 were in one room and 5-8 were in the other room. They at lunch in their classoom. School went from 9:00 to 4:00. The lunch and recess was from 12:00-1:00. They played ball usually at recess. My grandma had to walk two miles to school every day. She seldomly got a ride. When she moved into an old red brick house on Hintz Road, whe walked but she got rides more frequently than before. When she walked home, they would stop at a saw mill and get cider. Sometimes her mom would order things from the general store that was there and she's pick them up on her way home. When she got home, she had to get wood for the stove and she had to feed the chickens. She used to work the old plug style switchboard for the telephone company. She started the job in 1939 when she was nineteen and worked about ten years. In 1942, after my grandma and grandpa got married, they moved above Wheeling Farms, a store. They moved into their house next to Whitman school in 1945 and they still live their today. There phone number then was 368.

My mom's Uncle has lived in Wheeling all his life. He ran a merry-go-round when there was a fair in the forest preserve. My dad's father moved to Wheeling when he was a boy. He lived on a

farm by Palwaukee airport. He talks of how he used to help pull the blimps down when they came to Wheeling.

My family has lived in Wheeling for many, many years. They have contributed a lot to this town. I have had five generations of family living in Wheeling. Almost all of them still reside in Wheeling.
