#### HONEY-MUSTARD PORK CHOPS

1 can chicken broth, 2 tsp. lemon pepper seasoning, 1 C uncooked rice, 2 scallions, chopped, 4 pork loin rib chops, 3/4 thick, about 2lbs., 2tbs. Honey mustard.

Reserve 1/4 cup broth. Add enough water to remaining broth to equal 2 1/4 cups. In pot, mix broth mixture with 1 tsp. lemon pepper; over high heat, bring to boil. Stir in rice; over low, cook covered until tender, 20 minutes. Stir in scallions. Rub chops with remaining lemon pepper. In nonstick skillet, heat 1 Tbs. oil over medium-high heat. Add chops; cook turning once, until no longer pink near bones, 6-8 min per side. Remove; keep warm. Stir mustard into skillet. Add reserved broth. Over high heat bring to boil; over medium, cook stirring 1 minute. Return chops and accumulated juices to skillet; cook until sauce thickens, 1 minute. Serve with rice.

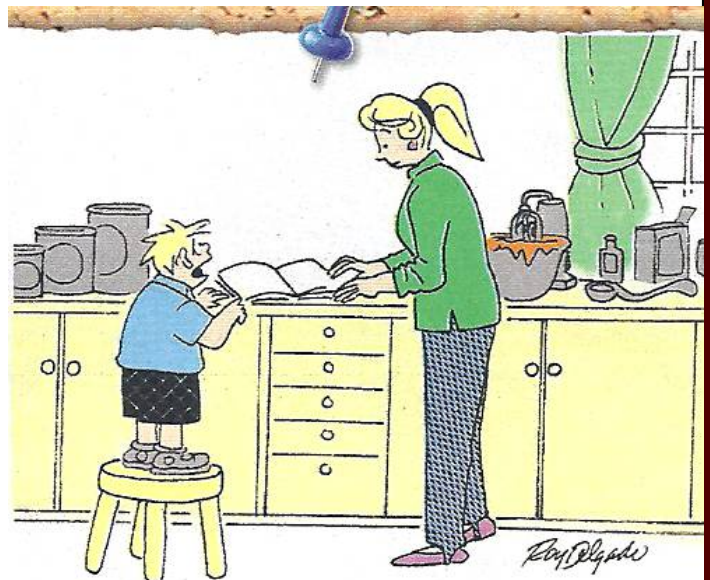
