ESTELLA UTPADEL

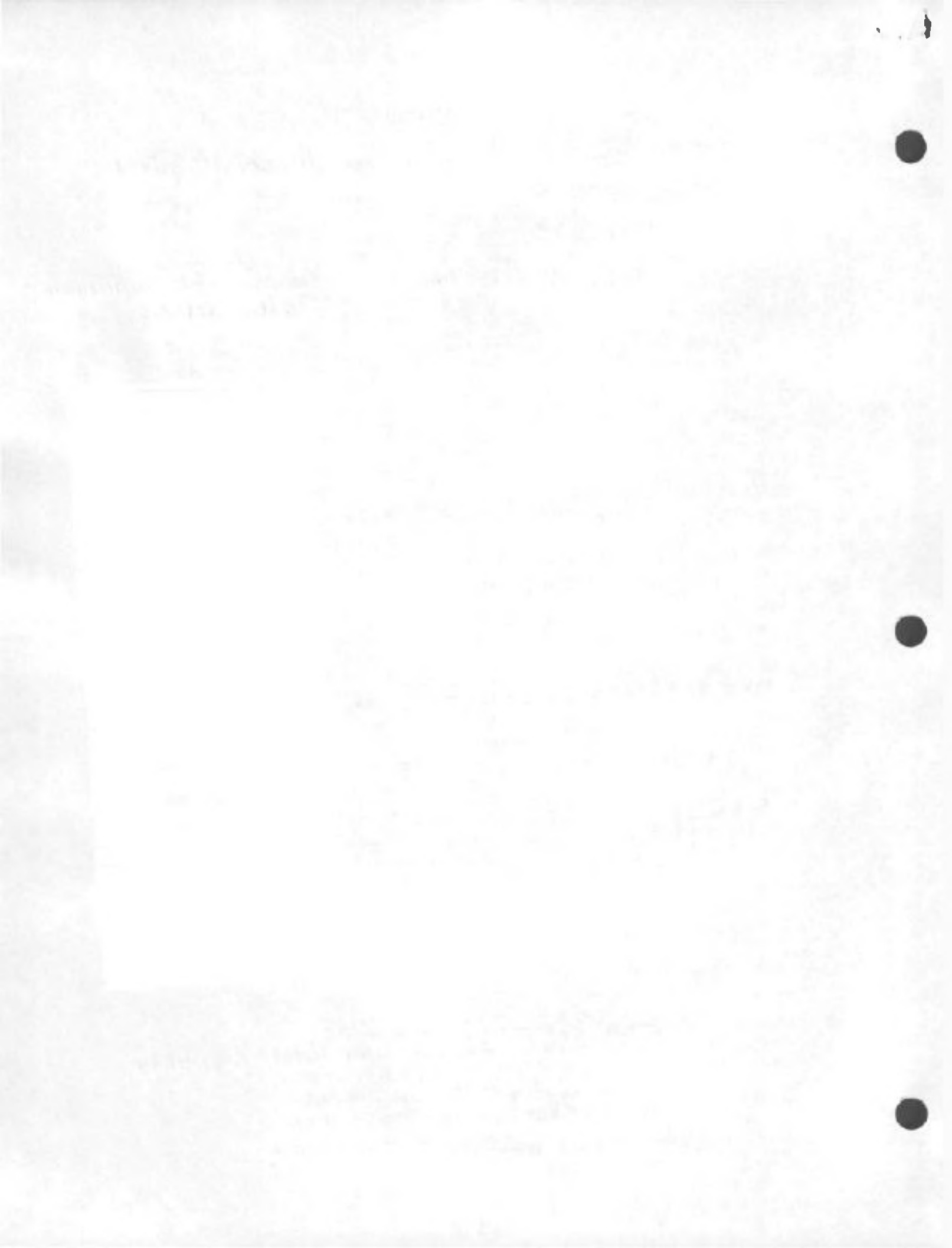
Estella Laurana Hank was born on May 11, 1893 and passed away at Springbrook Sanitarium, Aurora after a lingering illness, on Sept 10, 1934, at the age of 41 years and 4 months.

Her childhood was spent on the farm home north of Wheeling and as a young lady she was employed in one of the local stores. On May 26, 1915, she was married to Mr. Albert Utpadel, Jr., and until 5 1/2 years ago they made their home in Wheeling. She was active in the social life of the village, being a past oracle of Wheeling Camp Royal Neighbors, a charter member and past matron of Wheeling chapter O. E. S., and a member of Wheeling Presbyterian church. She was also an active member of Armathea Shrine of Des Plaines.

About 5 1/2 years ago she and her husband left Wheeling to take up their residence in Elgin where they purchased a beauty shop business which they ran successfully. About 16 months ago she was stricken with a severe attack of tuberculosis, which she fought bravely and seemingly successfully the first year. About 4 months ago another attack came which eventually took her life.

She leaves to mourn her departure, her husband, Albert, her aged father, Jacob Hank, her sister, Mrs. E. Ehlers, 3 brothers, John, Edward and Willard and many other relatives and friends.

Funeral services were held from the home of her father on Thursday afternoon, Sept. 13.
