Mr. Jacob Wiest was born in a log cabin in Lake county, Ill., better known as Frye farm on Oct. 20, 1843. He lived there with his parents until his marriage. On Feb. 5, 1868, he was married to Miss Magdalena Phlaum, with whom he shared life's joys and sorrows for over 52 years. The first few years of wedded life were spent in farming in Minnesota. Ill health brought them back to Illinois where he followed the carpenter trade, spending the remainder of his life in this locality. Wheeling Loses Old Time Resident by Death Mrs. Welflin

Mrs. Godlobin Welflin was born in Bittenfeld, Germany on January 1, 1845 and departed this mortal life March 15, 1928. Her age was 83 years 2 months and 14 days.

She came to the United States with her parents and sisters and brothers in the year 1854 and the family settled at Black Rock Creek near Buffalo, New York, and a year later moved to Long Grove, Illinois.

She entered into marriage with Martin Ambruster in 1866. To this union were born four children, one dying in infancy and the remainder now living: Charles A., Anna M., and John A. Mr. Ambruster passed away in January 1880.

Mrs. Ambruster was then married to Christian Welflin, 4 children blessed this union, all now living: Edward J. Welflin and Frank W. Welflin of Wheeling, as well as Mrs. Minnie M. Bolling and Flora E. Flesch.

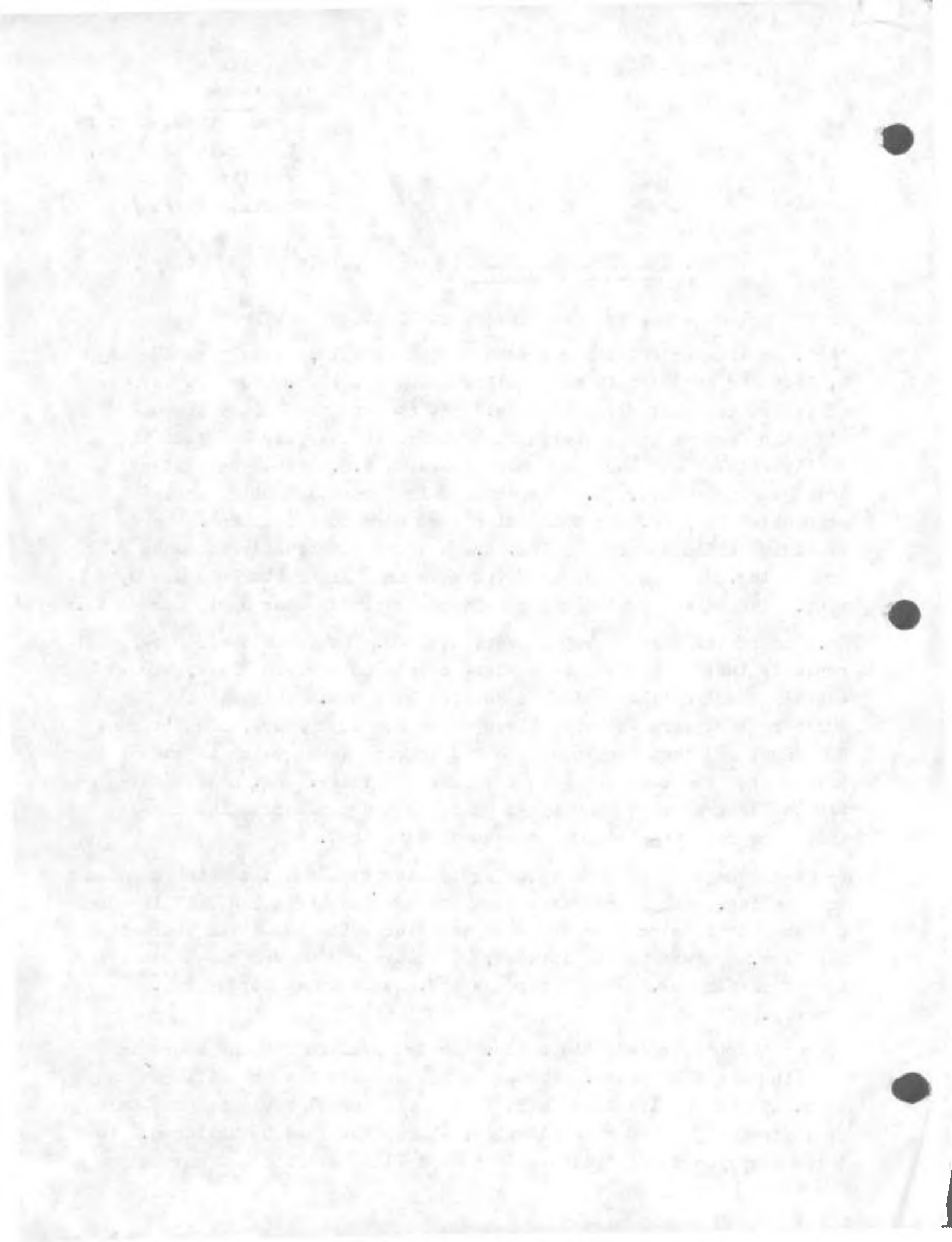
Dorothy Flentge quotes from Paddock Publication of 1928

"Mrs. Armbruster Welflin was born in Bittenfield, Germany on January 1, 1845 and parted this mortal life March 15, 1928. Her age was 83 years, two months and 14 days." She came to the United States with her parents and sisters and brothers in the year 1854 and the family settled at Black Rock near Buffalo, N.Y. and a year later moved to Long Grove, IL. She entered into marriage with Martin Armbruster in 1866. To this union were born four children. The remaining children are Charles. A., and Anna Armbruster and John A. Armbruster. I am sure some of you knew Anna Armbruster who was my aunt. She never married and remained Anna Armbruster until her death.

Mr. Armbruster passed away January of 1880. Now, I know from personal contacts that they lived as a young couple on Buffalo Creek, almost exactly where Shirley and John Koeppen live now. This was the Buffalo Creek Farm and they lived there for some years, I don't know how many, and then they moved to the Chicago House which is the old Amvets area and they were the shop keepers there. Mr. Armbruster was the tavern keeper and my grandmother and her three kids lived there and ran Chicago House and he died in 1880.

So my grandmother and the three Armbruster kids ran the Chicago House in Wheeling. Very soon after that she married Christian Welflin who was an old bachelor harness maker and blacksmith who lived here in Wheeling. He was in his forties, I believe and he and his sister came from Germany. His sister was Mrs. Burke up at Burke Bros. Brewery.

Four children blessed this union. Edward Welflin ran the store in Wheeling for many years. He had Howard and Don who are still in the area. Frank Welflin lived next to the old school house and ran Chicago House for many years with his wife, Flora; they had no children. Then there was my mother, Minnie Welflin and Flora Welflin who married a man from Chicago.

History of the Church

Community Presbyterian Church is the oldest church in the Wheeling community. It's history dates back to the early eighteen fifties when religious services were held in the school house and homes.

The first meeting for the purpose of organizing the German Evangelical United Reformed and Lutheran Church was held May 1, 1864. By the fall of that year, a decision was made to unite with the Presbyterian Church, U.S.A. and on November 2, 1864 the German Zion Church became a part of the Presbytery of Chicago.

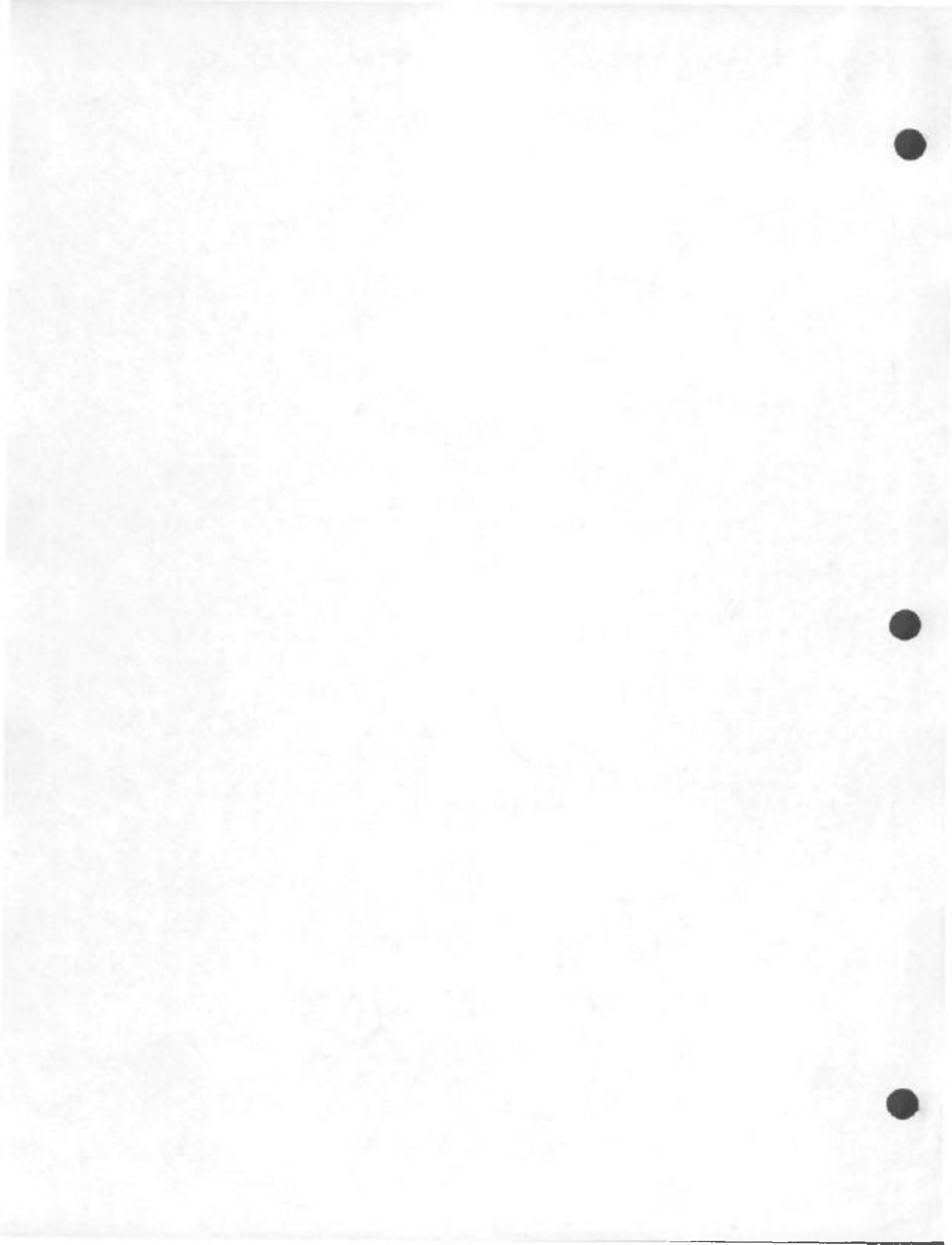
At this time, the following persons declared themselves members of the new congregation: G. Murbach, Conrad Zimmer, Jacob Zimmer, A. Fassbender, Werner Spengler, William Vogt, Christian Walter, Jacob Glos, Conrad Baerthel, A. Weber, A. Schminke, David Murbach, Nicholas Boch and David Fritsch. Four days later the following names were added to the congregation: Melchior Kranz, Julius Baerthel, Elisabeth Werley, Ellen Fassbender, Christian Murbach, Salome Zimmer and Dorothea Baerthel.

They continued to meet in the school house for worship, but in the fall of 1865, the first church was built. Zion Presbyterian Church, long a landmark near the corner of Dundee Road and Milwaukee Avenue, became an influential center of community activity.

Session failed to submit it's minutes to Presbytery until the year 1875, when the following was entered upon that record: "Approved by Presbytery, April 13, 1875 with the recommendation that the records be kept in the English language." However, worship services continued to be held in German until 1918. For a time the church was a part of the Galena Presbytery but at the time the decision was made to hold services in English, the church was transferred back to the Chicago Presbytery.

In July of 1926, the church steeple was struck by lightening. And in June of 1948, the name was changed to Community Presbyterian Church of Wheeling. With the population growth and land development in the mid-1900's, it was decided to build a new church facility. The first services in the new building were held Christmas 1962.

The original building was purchased by the Wheeling Historical Society and is located at Chamber of Commerce Park, (N. Wolf Road) in Wheeling.

SAMUEL B. WARNECKE

Samuel B. Warnecke was born in Germany at Oevrnum on the island Foehr, Nov. 4, 1877. He came to America in 1893 and settled in Chicago where he resided until coming to Wheeling 8½ years ago. April 24, 1900, he was united in marriage to Miss Wiebke Stange. While living in Chicago they conducted a business on the northwest side of the city where Mr. Warnecke made many friends. He took an active part in civic and social affairs, as well as caring for his business and carried memberships in the following lodges, Kelvyn Park Lodge No. 1075 A. F. & A. M.; Palmer Square Chapter No. 259 R. A. M.; Humboldt Park Council No. 113 R. A. S. M.; Humboldt Park Commandery No. 79 K. J.; Medinah and Chicago Lodge No. 4 B. P. O. E.

Mr. and Mrs. Warnecke came to Wheeling in Dec., 1924 to become the proprietors of the Chicago House, where they continued their reputation of serving first class meals. Mr. Warnecke made extensive repairs on the Chicago House, enlarging and beautifying the building and grounds making it an attractive place to stop for diners.

As in Chicago, so in Wheeling Mr. Warnecke was actively interested in civic affairs. At the time of his death he was serving his second term as trustee of the village.

Although having been warned by his physician to watch his health, he continued in his business activities and on the day of his death had motored to his summer cottage where he was busy putting on the screens when he was stricken. A physician was called at once, but death had claimed Mr. Warnecke on June 15, at the age of 55 years and 6 months.

The body was removed to the home at Wheeling to remain there until 10 o'clock on Monday, the 19th, when he was removed to the Humboldt Park Commandery, to lie in state until the hour of the service, 2 p. m. The Commandery hall was crowded with fellow members and friends for the services which began promptly at 2 o'clock. The service opened with a solo, "Sleep Thy Last Sleep," beautifully sung by Madame Dorothea Derrfuss, a close friend of the family. This was folowed by the sermon and prayer by Rev. E. L. Shaw,

after which Madame Derrfuss sang, "There Is No Death." Following this the Knight Templars of Humboldt Park Commandery conducted the beautiful funeral ritual of their organization. 139 cars formed the funeral procession which carried the remains to the Irving Park cemetery where the fellow members of Kelvyn Park Lodge A. F. & A. M. conducted the ceremony.

4-year-old David Welflin dies suddenly

Word of the death of little David John Welflin, son of Mr. and Mrs. Donald E. Welflin struck the people of Wheeling like a thunderbolt from a clear sky. Saturday David played happily with the children of the neighborhood.

While at the breakfast table Sunday he began feeling ill and soon showed signs of paralysis. Immediately after the arrival of a doctor he was rushed to Billings Memorial hospital in Chicago where the best specialists were put on his case.

After numerous tests the diagnosis was given as a rare blood disease, of which only three previous known cases are on record in Chicago. The blood disturbances caused a toxic condition bringing on a paralysis of the nerves which took his life at 10:30 Sunday evening. The attack was believed to be a recurrence of the disease which first was evident about 21 months ago, but then was thought to have been polio. An autopsy confirmed the doctor's present diagnosis that no polio germs were present.

David John was born in Oakland, California March 30, 1945 and would have been five years old next spring. After Mr. Welflin's release from the Air Force the family returned to Wheeling. Funeral services were held Wednesday morning at St. Mary's church, Buffalo Grove, where the Angels Mass was sung. Burial was made in Ridgewood cemetery next to his great-grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. John Meyer.

Besides his grief-stricken parents and grandparents, David is survived by his 9 month old brother, Donald Mark, and many other relatives and friends.

Welflin was married twice. He met his first wife while stationed in New York. They had just one child, John, who is a music teacher in Higginsville, Mo.

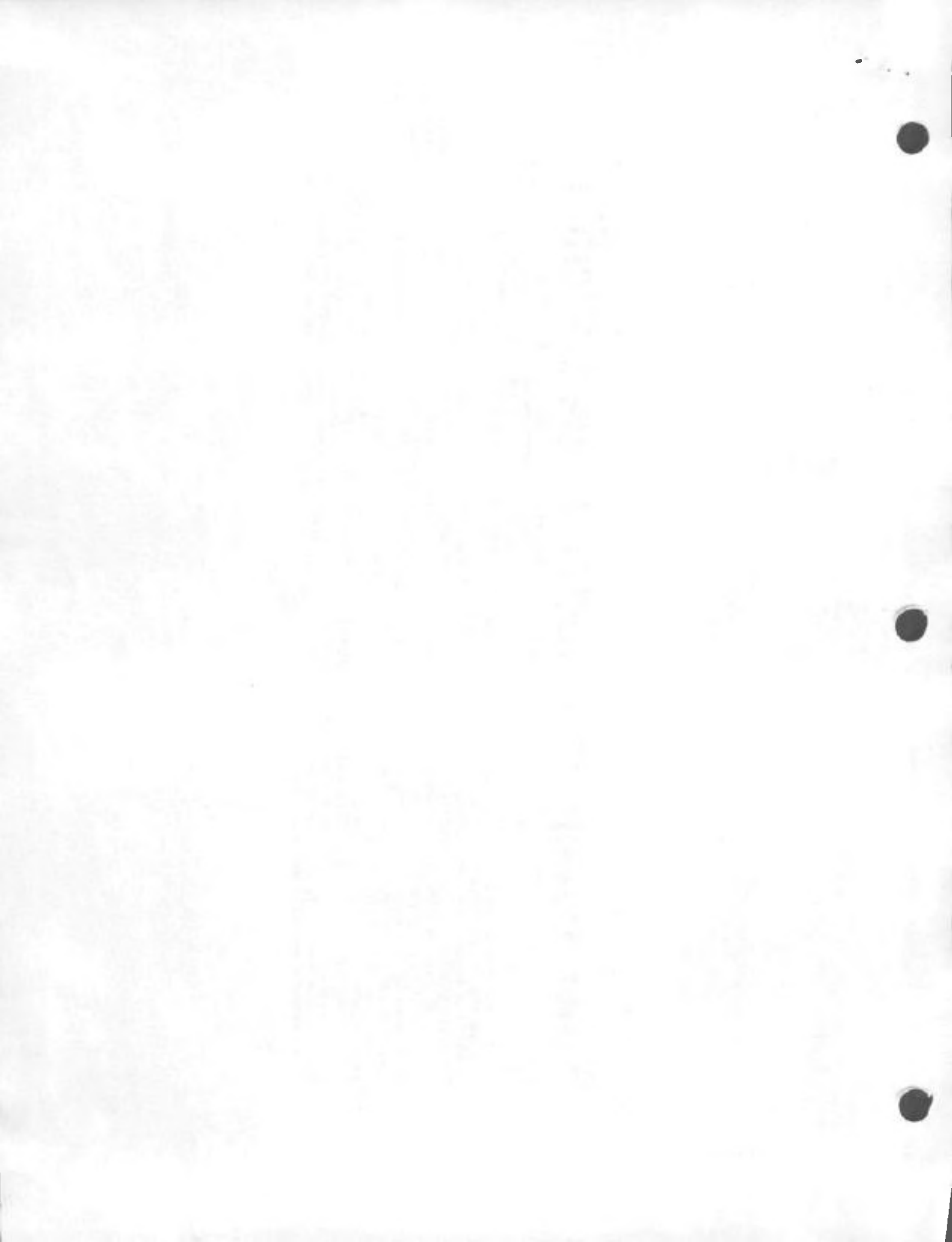
Edward Welflin said a favorite family story about his brother involved his Army training, when he was an officer's candidate alongside none other than Clark Gable.
